Dr. Clyman is a board certified genetic counselor with more than 15 years of clinical genetics experience. He has provided genetic counseling in a variety of settings, including prenatal, pediatric, and neurogenetic.

For the last 10 years, he has focused on oncology, specializing on familial cancer risk assessment and evaluation for genetic and genomic testing. Prior to training as a genetic counselor at Brandeis University, Waltham, MA, including an internship at the Dana-Farber Cancer Center in Boston, MA, Dr. Clyman earned a PhD in molecular biology from the State University of New York at Albany. He went on to perform post-graduate research in genetics for seven years, including five at the New York State Department of Health in Albany.

Dr. Clyman has been involved in the training of family practice residents and physicians in clinical genetics. He has given many public presentations on cancer genetics and recently served on an American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists task force to develop physician recommendations for patient colorectal cancer screening.



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
